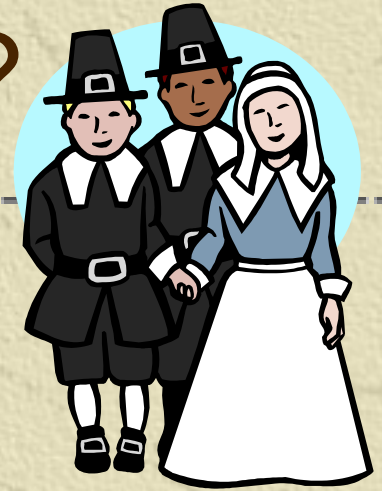

# Who were the Pilgrims?

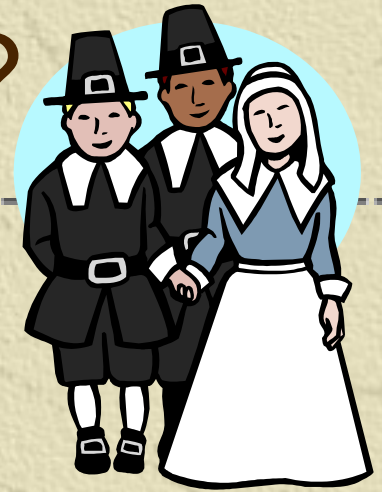


✠ The Pilgrims came from England



✠ They left England because they wanted freedom to practice their religion, not the Church of England. They were called “Separatists.”

# Who were the Pilgrims?

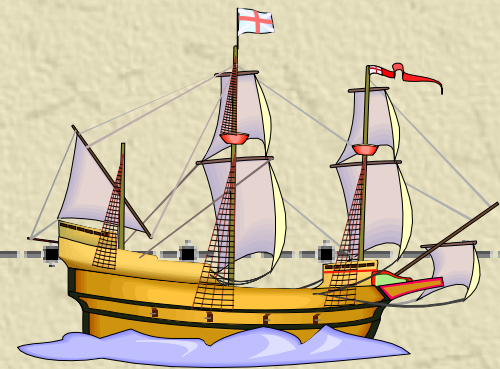


✠ They sailed on a ship called the Mayflower



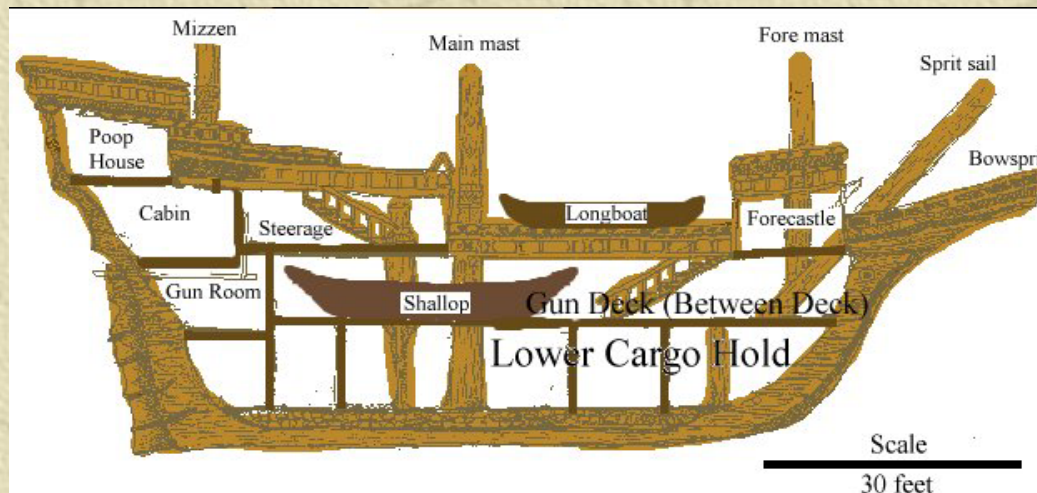
✠ They left England on September 6, 1620

# The Mayflower



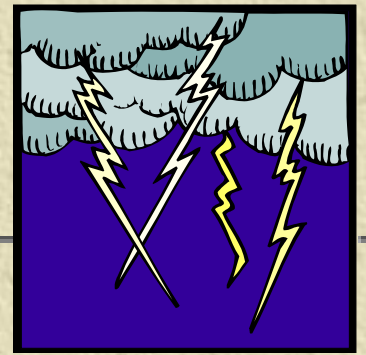
✠ The ship measured 113 feet long from the back rail to the end of the bowsprit beak

◆ How long is that?

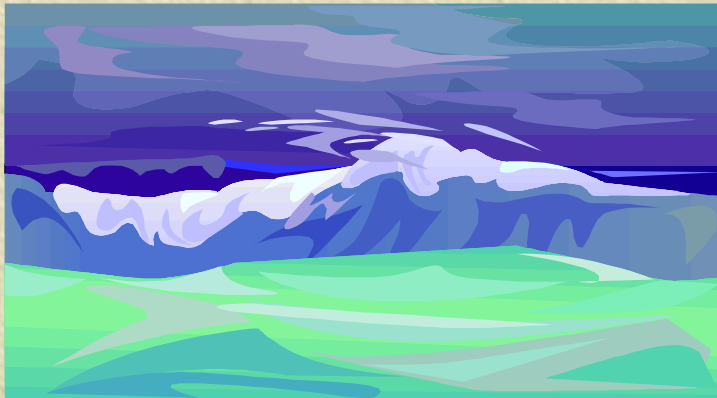


✠ It sailed with 102 passengers and more than 30 crew members!

# Storms on the Atlantic!!

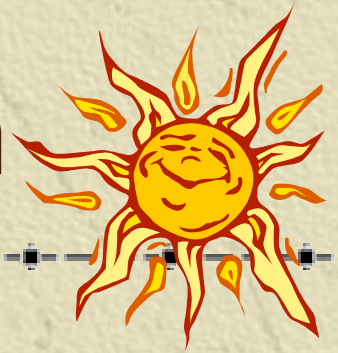


✠ William Bradford, the Pilgrims' leader, wrote in his journal:



After they had enjoyed fair winds and weather for a season, they were encountered many times with cross winds, and met with many fierce storms, with which the ship was shroudly shaken, and her upper works made very leaky; and one of the main beams in the mid ships was bowed and cracked, which put them in some fear that the ship could not be able to perform the voyage.

# Safe Arrival at Plymouth

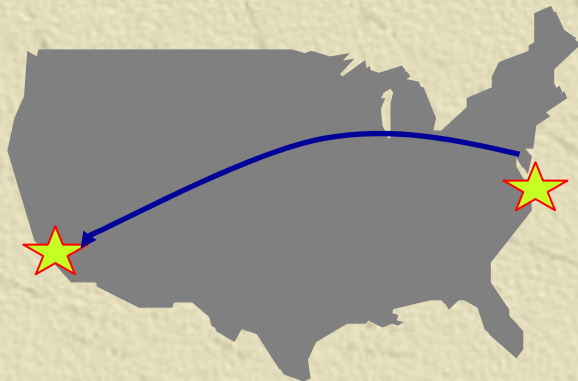


✠ It took 66 days to cross the Atlantic Ocean

- ◆ That's over two months on a ship!

✠ The voyage from Plymouth, England to Plymouth Harbor was about 2,750 miles

- ◆ That's like going from Williamsburg to Los Angeles, California!



✠ They finally arrived at Provincetown, Massachusetts on November 11, 1620
