Rules of House of Warriors.

1. The Speaker, Clerk and Interpreter shall take the chair precisely at the hour to which the House stands adjourned, and the Speaker shall immediately call the House to order; and every morning the Chaplain shall open the session with prayer.

2. After calling the roll and marking the absentees, if a quorum be present, the minutes of the last meeting shall be read, and if requisite, corrected and approved. The reading of the minutes may be suspended upon motion of the House.

3. It shall be the duty of the Speaker at all times to preserve order and to endeavor to conduct all business before the House to a speedy and proper result.

4. It shall be the duty of the Clerk immediately to file all BILLS or papers in the order in which they have been read,

with proper indorsements, and to keep them in perfect order.

5. It shall be the duty of the Speaker to carefully keep notes of all business or BILLS which may be assigned to particular days, and call them up at the time appointed.

6. The Speaker may speak to points of order, in preference to other members, rising from his seat for that purpose, and shall decide questions of order subject to an appeal to the House by any member.

7. Business left unfinished at the last meeting shall be taken up first.

8. A motion made must be seconded before it is debated, and every motion shall be reduced to writing if the Speaker or any member request it.

9. Any member who shall have made a motion shall have liberty to withdraw it with the consent of the second before it is debated, but not afterwards without the leave of the House.

10. Motion to lay on the table, to take

up business, to commit, to adjourn and to call for the previous question shall not be debatable.

11. When a motion is under debate, or pending, no motion shall be received except a motion to adjourn, to lay on the table, call for previous question, to commit, to amend: and the motion to adjourn shall always be in order.

12. An amendment may be moved on any motion and shall be decided before the original motion.

13. If the previous question be decided in the affirmative, the main question shall immediately be put; if in the negative the debate may proceed.

14. A question or measure shall not be again called up or reconsidered at the same session of Council at which it has been decided unless by the consent of two-thirds of the members who were present at the decision, and the motion to reconsider be made by members who voted with the majority.

15. Every member, when speaking,

shall address himself to the Speaker, and shall treat his fellow members, and especially the Speaker, with decorum, and respect.

16. No speaker shall be interrupted unless he be out of order, or for the purpose of correcting mistakes or misrepresentations.

17. No member in the course of debate shall be allowed to indulge in personal reflections.

18. If more than one member arise and address the Speaker at the same time, the Speaker shall recognize the one farthest from him.

19. If any member act in any respect in a disorderly manner, it shall be the privilege of any member and the duty of the Speaker to call him to order.

20. If any member consider himself aggrieved by a decision of the Speaker, it shall be his privilege to appeal to the House, and the question on such appeal shall be taken without debate.

21. All members not voting shall be

considered as acquiescing with the majority.

22. It shall be the duty of the Speaker to appoint all committees, except in the cases in which the House decides otherwise.

23. When the chair has commenced taking the votes no further debate or remarks shall be admitted, unless there has been a mistake, in which case the mistake shall be rectified and the chair shall proceed with the count.

24. The yeas and nays on any question shall be recorded when they are called for by any two members.

25. No smoking shall be allowed in the hall during the session of the House, and any member violating this rule shall be liable to a fine of twenty-five cents (25c.) for each offense.
