It is with great sorrow that we note the passing of Joseph L. Muscarelle on April 9 in Hackensack, New Jersey, at the age of 85. A member of the William and Mary class of 1927, Mr. Muscarelle and his wife Margaret were the principal benefactors of this Museum. His interest and pride in the Museum and its achievements were an outgrowth of his great love for the College of William and Mary. Joe, as everyone called him, was a genuinely caring, unassuming and generous individual. He was revered by the Museum's staff and friends and will be greatly missed by all.

ACCREDITATION

The Muscarelle Museum of Art became officially accredited by the American Association of Museums in November 1988. This is the highest award a museum can receive.
