

**APPENDIX X**  
**College of William and Mary Recreational Sports**  
**SPORT CLUB POINT SYSTEM**

Throughout the academic year, each sport club will have an opportunity to earn points for exceptional effort toward the overall improvement of their club, and negative points for certain policy infractions. At the end of the academic year, the points will be totaled, and budget allocations and practice space will be determined based upon overall points a club has earned (or lost). The following is a breakdown of the point system:

**Positive points earned for:**

+ 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Attending the mandatory Sport Club meetings (4 per year).</li> <li>• Giving a “club-to-club” presentation</li> </ul>
+4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Each event officially registered by using Appendix A and accompanied by a Concluding Event report (Appendix C) after the event has occurred. All administrative paperwork (trip plan, driver authorizations, etc.) must be filed properly in order to earn any points.</li> </ul>
+ 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Attending optional club officer workshops (approx. 1 per month)</li> </ul>

**Negative points deducted for:**

- 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Returning a van in unacceptable condition (e.g. trash inside, low on gas)</li> </ul>
- 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Forfeiting a game / match / event against another school without giving 48 hours notice to the other school and the SCC</li> <li>• Overdrawn on club checking account (with BB&amp;T)</li> </ul>
-5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• NOT attending a mandatory Sport Club meeting (4 per year).</li> </ul>

**“0” Point Balance and Possible Probation or Suspension**

In addition to the positive and negative points outlined above, a club may receive a “0 Point Balance” plus a possible probation for the following policy infractions. Each incident will be investigated by Recreational Sports, and a decision made thereafter.

- Alcohol / Drug Policy Violation (see Section III.D of the Sport Club manual (page 8))
- Fighting / violence during club-related activity
- Failure to submit ANY required risk management forms by deadline (generally within 24-48 hours of completion of form or occurrence of an incident). Includes Injury / Incident Report, Individual Informed Consent, & Demonstration of Safety
- Club Travel without first submitting a Trip Form (appendix B) and/or a driver submitting a “Driver Authorization Form” (Appendix D) prior to driving
- Participating as a William and Mary club in an unregistered event.
- Practicing / playing without proof of 2 certified First Aid / CPR members in attendance.
- Inappropriate content on club’s website.
