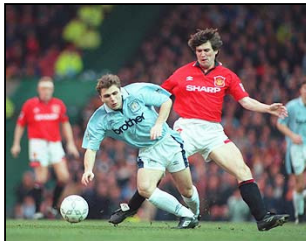
Q: Where to Begin?
