**APPLIED MUSIC FEE**

The College instituted the Applied Music Fee to support salaries paid to applied music instructors. The intent of the fee is to reduce the impact of applied music instruction on the overall funding of Educational and General Programs while continuing to provide this service to William and Mary students.

After reviewing the direct and indirect costs of this program, the administration recommends an Applied Music Fee of \$340, per semester for one thirty-minute lesson per week applicable to all applied music students, an increase of \$15 per semester. This fee structure allows the program to remain fully self-supporting.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Board of Visitors of the College of William and Mary in Virginia, on the recommendation of the Committee on Financial Affairs, approves an Applied Music Fee of \$340 per semester for one thirty-minute lesson per week, and \$680 per semester for one one-hour lesson per week.
