

## Transfer of Graduate Credit for Graduate Degrees in Arts and Sciences

On the recommendation of the student's major department/program committee and with the approval of the Dean of Research and Graduate Studies, a regular student may apply up to six hours of graduate credit earned at another accredited institution of higher learning toward an advanced degree at William and Mary. The credits must have been earned in courses appropriate to the student's program at William and Mary and must fall within the time specified by the general College requirements for degrees. Credit may be transferred only for courses in which the student received a grade of B or higher and will not be counted in compiling his or her cumulative grade point average at William and Mary.
