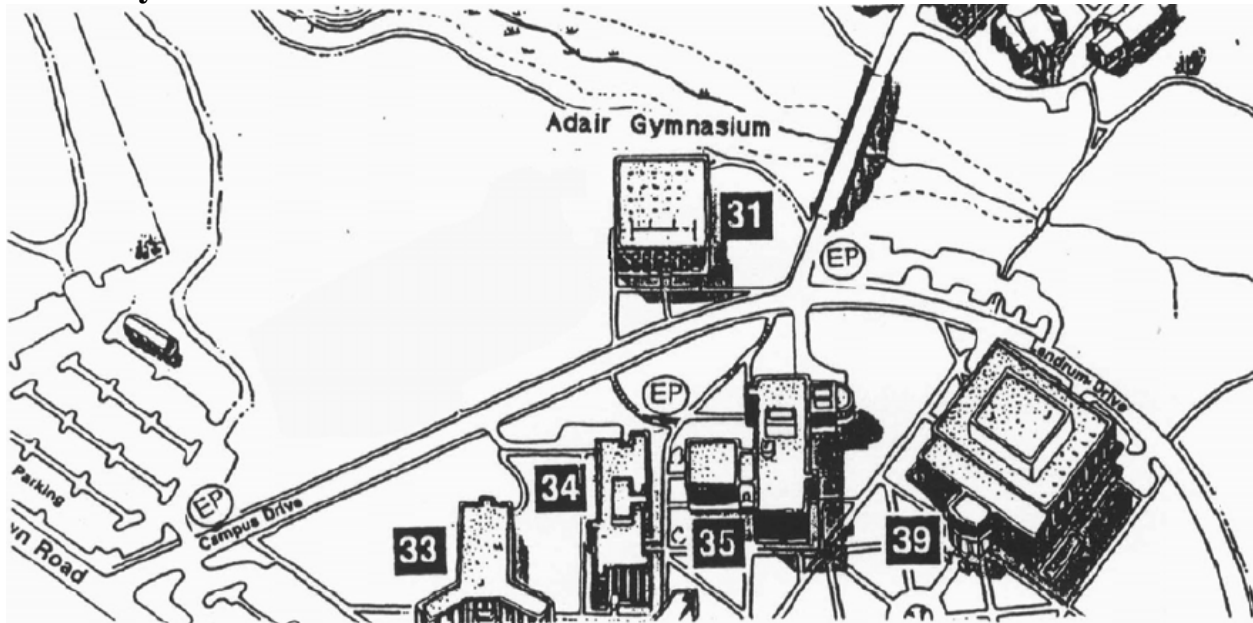


Emergency Plan Adair Gymnasium



Teams and individuals utilizing the **Adair Gymnasium** and/or **Tennis Courts** during intercollegiate events will be covered by the Sports Medicine Staff of the College of William and Mary subject to their availability and arrangements made prior to the event. The Sports Medicine coverage of this venue will be in contact with the Sports Medicine facility at William and Mary Hall via radio in case of an emergency situation.

If there is no on-site Sports Medicine staff, services may be sought at the Sports Medicine facility (221-3407) located across from the Busch Tennis Courts, on the lower level of William and Mary Hall. From the tennis courts, proceed across Brooks Street down the loading ramp to the outside door of the Sports Medicine facility.

In event the Sports Medicine facility is closed, there is an **emergency pole** at the following locations:

- Parking Lot on the corner of Campus Drive and Landrum Drive
- Across from Adair Gymnasium between Jones Hall and Small Physical Laboratory
- Common Glory Parking Lot at the corner of Campus Drive and Jamestown Road

The emergency pole is denoted with a blue light on top of the pole. There is a communication intercom connected directly to campus police at the emergency pole; simply press the button and talk into the speaker. You can also call **911** on any campus phone; you will reach campus police and they will be able to assist you. A Campus phone is located at the Adair Front desk. When using campus phones, dial "7" before dialing other phone numbers.

-Directions to Sentara Williamsburg Regional Medical Center Emergency Room (757-984-9647)
From Adair Hall turn right and follow Campus Drive to Jamestown Road. Turn right onto Jamestown road, and follow it to Route 199. Turn right onto Route 199. Follow Route 199 for approximately 5 miles to Rochambeau/Mooretown Road. Exit right onto Mooretown Road and follow Mooretown to the second stop light. Turn right onto Sentara circle and follow the signs and the circle to the Emergency Room.
