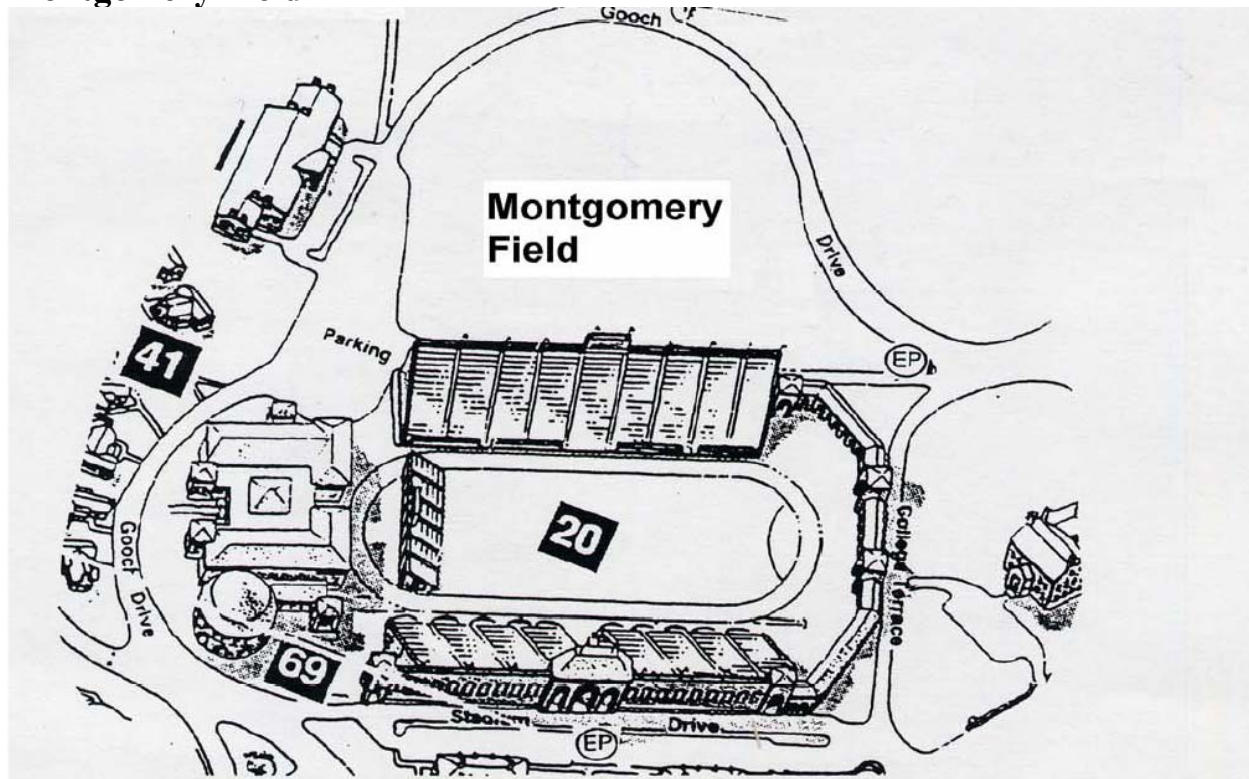


Emergency Plan Montgomery Field



Teams and individuals utilizing the **Zable Stadium** during intercollegiate events will be covered by the Sports Medicine Staff of the College of William and Mary subject to their availability and arrangements made prior to the event. The Sports Medicine coverage of this venue will be in contact with the Sports Medicine facility at William and Mary Hall via radio in case of an emergency situation.

If using this venue when there is no on-site Sports Medicine staff, services may be sought at the Sports Medicine facility (221-3407) located across from the Busch Tennis Courts, on the lower level of William and Mary Hall. From the tennis courts, proceed across Brooks Street down the loading ramp to the outside door of the Sports Medicine facility.

In event the Sports Medicine facility is closed, there is an **emergency pole** at the following locations:

- the corner of College Terrace and Gooch Drive just outside the gate of the football practice field entrance
- the center of the parking lot between the east side of the stadium and the Bryan Complex.

The emergency pole is denoted with a blue light on top of the pole. There is a communication intercom connected directly to campus police at the emergency pole; simply press the button and talk into the speaker. You can also call **911** on any campus phone; you will reach campus police and they will be able to assist you. Campus phones are located in adjacent buildings, the stadium athletic training room, football equipment room and baseball locker room (all located on the Press Box side of the stadium). When using campus phones, dial "7" before dialing other phone numbers.

Directions to Sentara Williamsburg Regional Medical Center Emergency Room (757-984-9647)
When you pull out of the Press Box side of the stadium, turn left onto Richmond Road. Turn left at Monticello Road. You will go through four stop lights and turn right onto Route 199. You will drive approximately 4 miles and exit right onto Rochambeau/Mooretown Road. Follow Mooretown Road to the 2nd stop light. Turn right onto Sentara Circle and follow the circle and signs around to the Emergency Room.
